Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

1. What is IGNITE-2026?

IGNITE-2026 is the 1st International Conference on Innovation & Growth in Next-Gen Intelligent Technology & Engineering, organized by KJ College of Engineering & Management Research (KJCOEMR), Pune.

2. Is IGNITE-2026 an IEEE conference?

Yes, IGNITE-2026 is technically sponsored by IEEE, and accepted papers are planned for submission to IEEE Xplore.

3. When will the conference be held?

17th – 19th June 2026

4. Where is the venue?

KJ College of Engineering & Management Research, Pune, Maharashtra, India.

5. Is the conference international?

Yes, researchers from India and abroad are invited to participate.

6. What is the theme of IGNITE-2026?

Innovation & Growth in Next-Gen Intelligent Technology & Engineering.

7. Who can attend the conference?

Researchers, academicians, industry professionals, and students.

PAPER SUBMISSION & REVIEW

8. How can I submit my paper?

Papers must be submitted through the CMT portal (link available on the conference website).

9. What is the last date for paper submission?

As mentioned in the Important Dates section on the website.

10. Can I submit only an abstract?

No, full-length papers must be submitted.

11. What format should the paper follow?

IEEE conference paper format (template available on the website).

12. What is the page limit for papers?

Typically 4–6 pages, as specified in the author guidelines.

13. Is plagiarism checked?

Yes, plagiarism checking is mandatory as per IEEE norms.

14. What is the acceptable plagiarism limit?

Generally below 10–15%, excluding references.

15. Can I submit multiple papers?

Yes, but separate registration is required for each accepted paper.

16. Can I modify my paper after submission?

Yes, only before the submission deadline.

17. Is the review process peer-reviewed?

Yes, all papers undergo a peer-review process.

18. Is the review process blind?

Yes, it follows standard blind peer-review guidelines.

19. Will reviewers provide comments?

Yes, review comments will be shared with authors.

20. Can I resubmit my paper after revision?

Yes, if revisions are requested by reviewers.

21. What happens if my paper is rejected?

The decision will be final, and the paper will not be published.

REGISTRATION & FEES

22. When does registration start?

After paper acceptance.

23. Where can I register?

Through the registration link shared via official email.

24. What are the registration categories?

- Student (UG/PG/Research Scholar)
- Faculty
- Industry Professional
- Attendee

25. Is early bird registration available?

If applicable, details will be updated on the website.

26. What payment modes are accepted?

Online payment modes as mentioned in the registration section.

27. Is the registration fee refundable?

No, the registration fee is non-refundable.

28. What does the registration fee include?

Conference kit, access to sessions, certificate, and proceedings.

29. Is accommodation included in the registration fee?

No, accommodation must be arranged separately.

PRESENTATION & PUBLICATION

30. Is participation mandatory for paper publication?

Yes, at least one author must register and present the paper.

31. Is physical presentation mandatory?

No. Participants can choose online (virtual) mode of presentation as well.

32. Is virtual presentation allowed?

Yes.

33. What is the presentation duration?

Typically 10–15 minutes per paper.

34. What language should the presentation be in?

English.

35. Can a co-author present the paper?

Yes, any registered author may present.

36. Will certificates be provided?

Yes, participation and presentation certificates will be issued.

37. Will papers be published in IEEE Xplore?

Accepted and presented papers will be submitted to IEEE Xplore.

38. Is publication guaranteed after acceptance?

Only if the paper is presented and passes IEEE quality checks.

39. Will DOI be assigned?

Yes, after indexing in IEEE Xplore.

40. Will the proceedings have an ISBN?

Yes, the conference proceedings will have an ISBN number.

TRACKS, AWARDS & SESSIONS

41. Can interdisciplinary papers be submitted?

Yes, if relevant to the conference theme.

42. Are industry case studies allowed?

Yes.

43. Are review papers accepted?

Yes, subject to quality standards.

44. Will keynote sessions be conducted?

Yes, by eminent speakers.

45. Will there be best paper awards?

Yes, best paper awards may be given track-wise.

VENUE & LOGISTICS

46. How can I reach the venue?

Directions are available on the Contact/Location page of the website.

47. Is parking available?

Yes, parking is available on campus.

48. Are nearby hotels available?

Yes, a list of nearby hotels is provided on the website.

49. Will conference kits be provided?

Yes, one conference kit per registered paper.

CONTACT & UPDATES

50. Whom should I contact for technical queries?

Contact details are available in the Contact section of the website.

51. Where can I get updates about the conference?

Through the official IGNITE-2026 website and email notifications.

52. Are students allowed to attend without submitting a paper?

Yes, students may attend the conference as participants without submitting a paper by registering under the attendee category.

53. Is prior IEEE membership required to submit a paper?

No, IEEE membership is not mandatory for paper submission or presentation.

54. Will the conference provide a detailed schedule?

Yes, the detailed conference schedule will be published on the website before the event.

55. Will authors receive presentation guidelines?

Yes, presentation guidelines and templates will be shared with accepted authors via email.

56. Can authors request a specific presentation date or session?

Session allocation will be decided by the organizing committee; specific requests cannot be guaranteed.

57. Will there be parallel technical sessions?

Yes, parallel technical sessions may be conducted depending on the number of accepted papers.

58. Are workshops or tutorials planned during the conference?

If applicable, details of workshops or tutorials will be announced on the website.

59. Can industry professionals attend without presenting a paper?

Yes, industry professionals may attend as participants by completing the registration process.

60. Is there a separate registration fee for attending keynote sessions?

No, keynote sessions are included in the conference registration fee.

61. Will conference photographs be shared with participants?

Yes, selected photographs will be shared through the official website or email.

62. Can authors withdraw their paper after acceptance?

Paper withdrawal requests must be communicated to the organizing committee before final submission to IEEE Xplore.

63. Will food and refreshments be provided during the conference?

Yes, refreshments and lunch will be provided on conference days.

64. Will attendance be recorded for participants?

Yes, attendance will be recorded and is mandatory for certificate issuance.

65. Can participants attend only one day of the conference?

Yes, participants may attend selected days, but registration fees remain unchanged.

66. Will hard copies of certificates be provided?

Certificates will primarily be issued in digital format; hard copies may be provided if announced.

67. Can international participants get an invitation letter?

Yes, invitation letters will be provided to registered international participants upon request.

68. Is visa assistance provided by the conference?

The conference can provide invitation letters but does not handle visa processing.

69. Will the organizing committee assist with local travel guidance?

Basic local travel and location guidance will be shared on the website.

70. Can late registration be allowed?

Late registration may be permitted subject to availability and committee approval.
